I am a researcher specializing in philosophy of law. I focus on universal values, prevention of aggression, violence, justification of tolerance as one of the basic principles of modern democracy (the topic of my doctoral dissertation). In addition, I studied and continue to study the problems of countering international terrorism, its theoretical aspects (the topic of my Ph.D. thesis). My doctoral dissertation is devoted to the study of violence and tolerance as paired phenomena and categories. It was the first research work on this subject in Ukraine. In addition to scientific research, I am engaged in disseminating knowledge about the anti-culture of militarism, about the need to develop a culture of tolerance. For example, I am the author of the first monograph in Ukraine on aggression and tolerance. I also personally teach a number of courses that are devoted to issues that have become extremely relevant in the war of the militaristic Russian Federation against the peaceful Ukraine. The circle of my listeners is both a large audience of students and small groups of enthusiasts who are interested in the problems that oppose the introduction of democracy in modern Ukraine.
